RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe regulates its vital wildlife resources and recreational activities through the laws as implemented in the Tribal Game and Fish Code; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes that the Tribal Game and Fish Code has needed a major revision; and
- WHEREAS, the Game and Fish Department and the Legal Department have just completed thorough revision of the Code.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Council Secretary to post the proposed amendments in each District for ten days as required by the Constitution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 04, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>one</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
