## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Whiteriver Assembly of God Church has requested a church lease; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Legal Department has prepared a proposed church lease identical to leases previously executed by the Catholic Church, Church of Latter Day Saints, and Lutheran Church and which previously had been approved by the Tribal Council in form and content; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Pastor Martin of the Assembly of God Church is being provided a copy of the proposed lease with the Whiteriver Assembly of God Church and that he has been invited to make his comments and suggestions reference the lease; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council nevertheless wishes to table further action on the church lease for the Whiteriver Assembly of God at this time until further review.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby tables the church lease for the Whiteriver Assembly of God until further review and discussion regarding said lease.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 7, 1994</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribe Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (m), (n), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
