## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by Resolution No. 07-94-202 directed the Tribal Council Secretary to post the proposed amendments to the Enrollment Code in each district for a minimum of 10 days as required by the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, the Council Secretary advised the Tribal Council that said proposed ordinance has been posted in accordance with that directive; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council have received no opposition to the proposed amendments to the Enrollment Code concludes that Ordinance No. 187 amending the Enrollment Code should be enacted.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts Ordinance No. 187 amending the Enrollment Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

**BEIT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that the acts and deeds of the members of the Tribal Council necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution be, and the same are hereby ratified, confirmed and adopted as the acts and deeds of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 08, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
