## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Alchesay High School (AHS) Falcon Pride Club has come before the Tribal Council and has explained its organization, mission, goals and its fund raising activities; and
- WHEREAS, the goals of the AHS Falcon Pride Club is to provide positive alternatives for youth in the community, to pursue fund raising activities for support programs for youth, to establish a scholarship fund at Alchesay High School, to help create, develop and maintain a youth center/crisis center for youth, and to serve as a positive role model for younger students; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council appreciates the efforts being made by these outstanding and civil minded students to help youth on the White Mountain Apache Reservation and for their promotion of good citizenship amongst youth; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes that members of the AHS Falcon Pride Club and other students within the Reservation represent the Tribes future leadership and hope and wishes to support the club, its members and its goals; and
- WHEREAS, the AHS Falcon Pride Club advises the Tribal Council that it intends to make a symbolic walk to Washington, D.C. for youth and is requesting sponsors for each mile; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to sponsor the first mile of the walk to Washington, D.C.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recognizes the Alchesay High School Falcon Pride Club.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby extends its appreciation and praise to the AHS Falcon Pride Club for the goals and mission that it has adopted for the benefit of youth on the White Mountain Apache Reservation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby sponsors the first mile of the AHS Falcon Pride Club's walk for youth to Washington, D.C.

The foregoing resolution was on October 06, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
