RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council observes that many employees have come before the Tribal Council with requests that their annual of sick leave be transferred to a friend or relative because that friend or relative is very ill or is hospitalized and will exhaust his or her own sick or annual leave before medical recovery is achieved; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it would be more efficient and would assist Tribal members if authority to transfer sick and annual leave was delegated to the Human Resources Director and that the Director be instructed to verify that the person to whom the annual or sick leave will be transferred is hospitalized or ill and in need of the transferred hours.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby delegates authority to the Director of the Human Resources Department to honor all requests for the transfer of annual or sick leave from one employee to another but only for reasons of hospitalization or severe illness which would require said transfer.
- BEIT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it is no longer necessary for a Tribal member to come before the Council with a request that he or she be granted authority to transfer his or her annual or sick leave to another employee.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Human Resources Director to verify the need for a transfer of sick or annual leave from one employee to another and to make appropriate recordation of said transfer of sick and annual leave from one employee to another but for medical reasons only.

The foregoing resolution was on October 06, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
