RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Member Jeanette Massey has come before the Tribal Council this date and has advised the Tribal Council that she presently lives in a house that was build in 1967, that the house is in dire need of roofing, flooring and presently has no heating source; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Massey requests Tribal Council assistance to repair her home; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Massey is disabled and is unable to complete said repairs with her own resources; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after discussion, concludes that Jeanette Massey should be assisted and that the Tribal Housing Authority should seek funding for repairs to older Housing Authority Mutual Help Homes which were built in the 1960's and in the older housing projects.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Housing Authority to seek available funding for the repair of Mutual Help Housing Units constructed in the 1960's and other older Mutual Help Homes which today are in need of repair.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it directs the Tribal Weatherization Department to assist Ms. Massey immediately with repairs and materials of her home.

The foregoing resolution was on November 2, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (j), (m), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
