

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, there is a Tribal Roads Committee which had been created pursuant to the Tribal Council authority; and

WHEREAS, there is a vacancy on the Roads committee at this time; and


WHEREAS, Council member Johnny Endfield recommends to the Tribal Council that Herbert Tate be appointed to the Roads Committee.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Herbert Tate is hereby appointed to the Tribal Roads Committee and shall serve in that capacity for the customary term of that appointment.

The foregoing resolution was on November 3, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
