

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, representatives of the U.S. Public Health Service, Whiteriver Unit, Katie Aday and Mike Huylebroeck have come before the Tribal Council and have requested funding from the Tribe to take eight (8) health career students from Alchesay High School to Washington, D.C. for the purpose of providing the health career students a first-hand tour of the U.S. Public Health Headquarters; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to encourage tribal youth to enter the health career area which will benefit the health and welfare of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the best way to proceed to assist the students is to match any funding that the students can raise through their own efforts.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby endorses the proposed trip to the U.S. Public Health Headquarters in the Washington, D.C. area for eight (8) health career students under the auspices of the Whiteriver Indian Health Service Unit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby pledges to match any funding that the students are able to raise for the trip to the U.S. Public Health Headquarters in the spring of 1995.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman and, in his absence Vice Chairman Lafe Altaha, to direct the Tribal Treasurer to appropriate funds sufficient to match the students' efforts for the proposed trip.

The foregoing resolution was on November 3, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
