

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** the Fort Apache Indian Reservation does not have a complete street address system in place; and
- WHEREAS,** the population and housing on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation has increased substantially since the last Tribal Council resolution (Resolution No. 75-79, May 7, 1975) naming the streets was adopted; and
- WHEREAS,** the need for a complete street address system throughout the Fort Apache Indian Reservation is vital for providing EMERGENCY SERVICES for residents and visitors of the Reservation; and
- WHEREAS,** the need for a complete street address system throughout the Fort Apache Indian Reservation is also vital for providing essential non-emergency services (utilities, telephones, UPS, mail, etc.) for residents and visitors of the reservation; and
- WHEREAS,** the ENHANCED 911 SYSTEM requires a complete street address system for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Police and Fire & Rescue Departments, in order to comply with and to fulfill the requirements of the ENHANCED 911 SYSTEM, and after consulting with other departments and agencies, have developed a reservation wide complete street address system.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that this street address system be adopted as the official street address system of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and that necessary non-tribal funding be sought to implement the system (purchase and installation of street signs).


The foregoing resolution was on February 02, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
