## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that Mr. Arnold Lupe and Mrs. Elvina (White) Lupe are requesting enrollment for their adopted daughter, Marie Angelle Lupe, DOB 11-22-91, with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that the Tribal Enrollment Committee completely reviewed Marie Angelle Lupe's enrollment application and supporting documents thereto; and
- WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee found Marie Angelle Lupe eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and that she possesses the necessary blood quantum of 1/2 White Mountain Apache blood through descendancy which exceeds Tribal Constitutional requirements for Tribal membership.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that based on the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee it hereby grants Mr. & Mrs. Arnold Lupe's request for enrollment of their adopted daughter Marie Angelle Lupe as a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 02, 1995</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article II, Section 1 and 2, and Article IV, Section 1 (o), (p) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
