

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Tribal member Breezy Johnson, Jr. has come before the Tribal Council this date with a request on behalf of his uncle, Prentice Bread, for reaffirmation of his place on the HIP housing list; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Johnson explains to the Tribal Council that his uncle, Prentice Bread, is a veteran and is presently in a nursing home but that his family wants him to return home, he is capable of coming home and can take care of himself; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that Mr. Bread is already on the District IV HIP list; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman suggest that the BIA point system be attached to the Resolution and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Mr. Bread's position on the HIP housing list should be reaffirmed.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms Mr. Prentice Bread's position on the District IV HIP housing list.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that a copy of the Bureau of Indian Affairs point System for HIP housing awards be attached to this Resolution and that Mr. Bread be prioritized on the District IV HIP housing list in accordance with that point system.

The foregoing resolution was on March 01, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
