

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs has a technical assistance grant program that can be used to improve existing operations on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has identified in the Overall Economic Development Plan some of the needs to include: increased efficiency at Apache Aerospace, increased independence from off reservation businesses, development of the Fort Apache Historic Park, and enhanced efficiency in the Tribe's dealing with procurement; and

WHEREAS, the following projects have been specifically developed to address these identified needs:

* Apache Aerospace sewing machine upgrades and enhancements	\$24,115
* Apache Print Shop new press and photo enlarger	\$50,000
* Fort Apache Historic Park development of snack bar facilities to serve food to the touring public to fully develop the gift shop to make it self supporting	\$50,000
* Development and implementation of new procurement policies and procedures	\$35,885

TOTAL PROJECT COSTS \$160,000

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Planning Department to develop and submit applications to BIA for Technical Assistance funds for the projects listed above.


The foregoing resolution was on March 08, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (j) and (k) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


