

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Councilmember Judy DeHose has come before the Tribal Council this date and has requested the Tribal Council to direct the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Land Operations Department, to rechannel and blade the area known as Seven Mile Junior Holy Grounds and for installation of a culvert to protect the integrity of the land in that area; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember DeHose suggests that Bill Walker and other appropriate BIA staff in the Land Operations Department be requested and directed to rechannel the drainage, blade and culvert the area; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in the request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that Superintendent Ben Nuvamsa direct the Fort Apache Agency Land Operations Department to rechannel the drainage, blade and culvert the as necessary at the Seven Mile Junior Holy Grounds as outlined in the attached drawing incorporated by reference in this Resolution.



The foregoing resolution was on March 08, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (h), (i), (m), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
