

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Mr. Noland Clay, President of the Canyon Day Community Association has come before the Tribal Council this date and advises the Tribal Council that the present Middle School in Whiteriver is inadequate to accommodate the number of students eligible to attend the school and the Canyon Day Community and a committee working with the Whiteriver School District 20 recommended that a middle school be established at Canyon Day; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Clay explains to the Council that Canyon Day has land available for a middle school and that representatives of the Canyon Day Community have met with the District 20 Whiteriver School District Superintendent and the District School Board; and


WHEREAS, the support of the Tribal Council is requested to pursue a middle school for Canyon Day; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Canyon Day Community should pursue the feasibility of establishing a middle school in Canyon Day with the District School Board and District Superintendent and that if all concerned conclude that the project is feasible, the Tribal Council will support a decision to establish a middle school at Canyon Day.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby endorses the efforts of the Canyon Day Community working with the District 20 School District Superintendent and District School Board to explore the feasibility of establishing a middle school at Canyon Day and that if all concerned are in favor and conclude that such a project is feasible, the Tribal Council will support such a project.

The foregoing resolution was on March 01, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
