

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development has issued the Notice of Funds Available for Supportive Housing funding; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has identified that a modern facility to house the alcohol patients who otherwise would be homeless and without services is a priority for the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Supportive Housing Program will provide up to \$400,000 for new construction, and a share of the operating costs of the facility and the support services required for the patients; and

WHEREAS, the project is in a state so that construction can begin immediately upon notification of grant award which is scheduled to be within 30 days of the application due date of April 7, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the project requires coordination with any other service providers to the homeless on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and the commitment of the necessary cash match.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Planning Department in conjunction with the Tribal Health Authority to develop and submit an application to HUD for funds for the development of a Supportive Housing application to develop a new alcohol treatment facility to address the needs of the homeless alcoholic population on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and to effect such coordination with any other service provider on the Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes that the required cash match of \$600,000 be committed for the construction of the facility and for 25% of the operating costs of the facility for the first two years and for 50% for the third year, and that other tribal programs such as child care, education, JTPA, and others be directed to address how they may contribute to solving the problem, and that the Health Nations Program planning take into account the need for coordination and mutual supportive effects.

The foregoing resolution was on March 08, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (j) and (k) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
