WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed that Rueben Kessay, Senior Criminal Investigator at the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fort Apache Agency has announced his retirement, effective March 31, 1995; and

WHEREAS, Rueben Kessay has served in law enforcement at the Fort Apache Agency for more than 27 years; and

WHEREAS, throughout his career in law enforcement Mr. Kessay has provided law enforcement services to the people of this Tribe and its guests and visitors which meet the highest professional standards; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to acknowledge the outstanding work of Rueben Kessay, who is a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby offers its sincere appreciation and utmost gratitude to Mr. Rueben Kessay for his many years of law enforcement with the Fort Apache Agency.


