## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member Larry Ethelbah has come before the Tribal Council this date and advises that he is presently owner of Hondah Homesite A-41 and is seeking Tribal Council consent to remove certain trees in order to expand his home; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Ethelbah explains that there are approximately fourteen (14) 5" diameter trees and three big trees that are suitable for the mill and that the trees have already been marked by BIA and that he has obtained all necessary permits and has also obtained the Tribal Engineer's approval for his building; and
- WHEREAS, the lots on either side of his home are vacant; and
- WHEREAS, he has also contacted the FATCO sawmill regarding the saw logs; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Mr. Ethelbah has obtained all necessary permits and approvals and, therefore, concludes that his requests should be granted.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to Tribal member Larry Ethelbah to remove the marked trees for expansion of his home.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (g), (h), (i), (m), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
