

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** Resolution No. 05-94-120 was duly adopted by the Tribal Council on May 12, 1994; and

**WHEREAS,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Arizona Department of Transportation have responded to the Tribe's request to make improvements to SR 73 in accordance with the above cited resolution; and

**WHEREAS,** negotiations have proceeded to the point of scheduling the projects previously selected to fiscal years for the construction of the project; and

**WHEREAS,** available funding has increased to allow additional intersections to be improved.



**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the projects listed below on the schedule shown below and the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to take any actions or execute any documents required hereafter to bring this about. It is understood and agreed that BIA Roads will fund the work listed for FY 1996, FY 1997 and FY 1998. ADOT will fund the work listed for FY 1999 to the extent possible with funds equal to one-third of the total obligated by BIA Roads for this work in the previous three years. Project numbers shown below are the same as the project numbers shown on the list attached hereto and made a part hereof.
