- WHEREAS, the Reverend Dr. Samuel Harris has been a full-time minister for the past forty three (43) years making many contributions to the communities and the world through his ministry of the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognized the extraordinary services Reverend Harris has provided to the Apache people as well as the dedication and energy he has expended for the spiritual growth of the White Mountain Apache people; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe acknowledges that this achievement is a great honor to have bestowed upon one of the members of the San Carlos Apache Tribe and thereby supports and approves this Holy endeavor.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby congratulates Reverend Harris and fully supports and recognizes the honor bestowed upon Dr. Samuel Harris for the many years of service and growth he has unselfishly provided to the Apache people.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 19, 1995</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
