

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Alchesay High School Falcon Pride Club has come before the Tribal Council this date to explain the status of its scheduled bike-a-thon and other activities; and

WHEREAS, the bike-a-thon is to commence June 4, 1995 and will arrive in Washington, D.C. on July 4, 1995; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that ten (10) youth will participate in the bike-a-thon which will have five adult chaperones as well as support bands; and

WHEREAS, the AHS Falcon Pride Club is requesting that the Tribal Council join with the Club when they embark on their journey June 4, 1995, and to join them in Washington, D.C. on July 4, 1995, the day they finish their journey; and also to pledge a dollar a mile to the Club's bike-a-thon; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is proud of the determination of these youth and the example they are setting, Reservation and Nation-wide, in their journey to Washington, D.C. on behalf of Reservation youth and youth everywhere; and

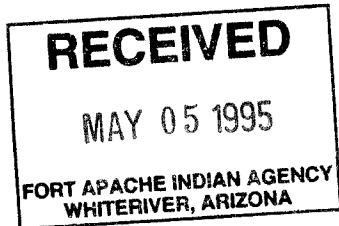
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to contribute and support the bike-a-thon.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby pledges Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00), which is one dollar per mile, to meet the AHS Falcon Pride Club members who complete the bike-a-thon journey.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it authorizes the Tribal Chairman to allocate the pledge money to the bike-a-thon as needed by the AHS Falcon Pride Club.

The foregoing resolution was on April 20, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
