RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is concerned about the health, safety and welfare of tribal members at sporting and rodeo events; and
- WHEREAS, in particular, the Tribal Council is concerned about the availability of emergency medical services for said sporting events and the fees that are to be charged for said services; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Tribal Chairman, Ronnie Lupe, should be delegated authority from the Council to negotiate with Emergency Medical Services a flat fee for the attendance of EMS at all sporting events and rodeos.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs Tribal Chairman to negotiate a flat fee for EMS Services for sporting and rodeo events.

The foregoing resolution was on May 03, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
