

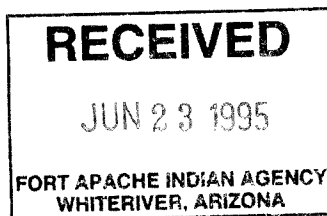
**RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**




WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the land board meeting minutes and is in agreement that the minutes should be approved without change.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the land board meeting minutes of April 11, 1995 as presented.

The foregoing resolution was on June 09, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Land Board Meeting
April 11, 1995

Members present: Slim Quay, Lula Ann Ivins and Esther T. Lupe.
The meeting opened at 9:22 a.m.

A regularly scheduled Land Board Meeting was held on April 11, 1995 in the Tribal Council Chambers.

Juan Antonio came before the board to request a farm land out in Cedar Creek. The farmland use to belong to his Aunt Gennie. Raymus will check into this to see which farm land are still open, because there are several peoples names are on the land out in the same area. There will be a special meeting when all the information is put together.

Cora Duryea requested a farm land in East Fork by the East Fork Mission school. Annie Holmes farm land. The house which is on the farmland belongs to Andrew and the land and apple trees belongs to Annie. Cora said the only people who farm there are Peter Nash, Viola White and herself (Cora). Raymus will put the farmland application together for her.

Eleanor Paxson came on behalf of her son Virgil Paxson. Virgil had requested a farm land and a livestock pasture. Virgil requested 65 acres of land in the McNary. Raymus told Eleanor that the livestock board members who signed the paper for Virgil stating that it was ok for him to receive 65 acres were probably not aware of it of how many acres there were given away. Raymus will talk with the Cedar Creek livestock board members. Raymus also told Eleanor that Virgil could add an addition to his homesite later on. Raymus told Eleanor that he would like to meet with him whenever he has time even on weekends to look at the land he was requesting.

Prescilla Schroeder requested a homesite in the North Fork Sub-Division lot #5, her homesite application was approved.

Tonita Standing- came on behalf of her mother Christine requesting a farm land out in Cibecue. Raymus told Tonita to talk to Hommer because he was the one who divided the farmland among the family members. And have Hommer relinquish the area Christine is requesting over to her.

Justin Williams came requesting a road be put in towards his son's land. As of now there is no road access. McDaniel (land office surveyor) has talked with Gilbert Early and Kenzie Manuel to see if they will let a road access through their land, but they both denied it.

Dorothy Baha - land dispute between her and Manuel Dazen. Dorothy said that Manuel had taken down all the new fence line and polls which they had put up and she wanted it to stop. McDaniel told her that the land Manuel received was surveyed from the old fence line not the new one so they were fencing in part of his land that is why he took down their fence's and polls. McDaniel will resurvey both lots and give Dorothy another addition to her lot.

Delphine Patterson requestd homesite, received lot next to Jacob Henry.

Pat Cooley requested farmland which belong to her mother in Cibecue farm # 41C. Turned in farmland application along with relinquishment which her mother relinquished to her.
