## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Mr. and Mrs. Spencer Lavender, Jr. are requesting enrollment for their adopted daughter Janicka April Lavender with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS. the Tribal Enrollment Committee has completely reviewed the enrollment application and supporting documents for Janicka April Lavender, whose birthdate is May 20, 1990; and
- WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee finds that Janicka April Lavender, whose blood quantum is 1/2 White Mountain Apache through descendancy, possesses the necessary blood quantum and is eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants Mr. and Mrs. Spencer Lavender, Jr. request for enrollment of their adopted daughter, Janicka April Lavender, into the White Mountain Apache Tribe, based on the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee, and subject to rescission pursuant to the Tribal Enrollment Code, Sections 1-202(c) and 1-704.

The foregoing resolution was on June 16, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article II, Section 1 (b), Sections 2 and 3; including Article IV, Section 1 (i), (q), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
