## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Council Member Johnny Endfield, Co-chairperson of the White Mountain Apache Fair and Rodeo Commission advises that the old liquor store is being renovated and that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair and Rodeo Commission, pursuant to a previous request approved by the Tribal Council, will soon be occupying the building as its permanent headquarters; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Endfield further advises that he received information that the Tribal Safety Program will be sharing the building with the Commission but that the Tribal Council had not approved a transfer of the Safety Office to the Fair and Rodeo Commission building; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is concerned that moving the Safety Department to the Tribal Fair and Rodeo Building will hamper the operations of both and that the Tribal Fair and Rodeo Commission should be the sole occupant of the renovated building; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that there is a conflict within the Fire Department in respect to providing space for the Safety Director Office; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Fire Department should be directed to make room in the fire station building to accommodate the Tribal Safety Program Director.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Fire Chief Clinton Kessay to immediately create adequate space in the fire station to accommodate the Safety Program Director and to report back to the Tribal Chairman when this Tribal Council directive has been completed.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 06, 1995</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>one</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
