

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 03-95-095, the Tribal Council amended the Tribal Personnel Policies and Procedures on Background Investigations; and

WHEREAS, the amendment permits the Arizona Department of Public Safety to receive and process fingerprint cards used for background investigations of noncriminal justice employees who provide services to minors; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe and the Department of Public Safety have drafted a User Agreement to regulate the procedures by which the Tribe and the Department of Public Safety will exchange the information necessary to conduct the background investigations; and

WHEREAS, under the Agreement, the Tribe will designate a System Security Officer who will coordinate the exchange of information between the Tribe and the Department of Public Safety.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the proposed User Agreement attached herein and delegates its authority to the Tribal Chairman or his designee to sign the agreement on behalf of the Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby delegates authority to the Tribal Police Chief to select the System Security Officer to coordinate the exchange of information called for under the Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the acts and deeds of the members of the Tribal Council necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution be, and the same are hereby ratified, confirmed and adopted as the acts and deeds of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on August 10 1995, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
