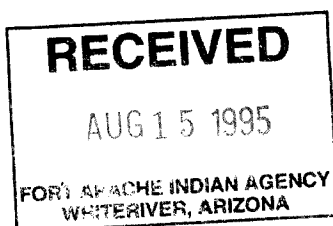


**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council is advised that the Bureau of Indian Affairs Roads Department is in immediate need of gravel for the purpose of repairing the River Road crossing below the Baptist Church; and
- WHEREAS,** the annual Tribal Fair and Rodeo festivities will be commencing toward the end of August and the beginning of September and the River Road access is a necessity because parade traffic is diverted along River Road; and
- WHEREAS,** it is necessary to replace the washed out River Road crossing below the Baptist Church with culverts and gravel; and
- WHEREAS,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs requests authorization from the Tribal Council to utilize the gravel locations either at Stago or Seven Mile Tank area; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council concludes that there is an immediate necessity to grant authorization to BIA Roads to utilize either location for gravel so that traffic can be diverted along River Road during the Tribal Fair and Rodeo, and further that repairs commence immediately.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes BIA Roads, Fort Apache Agency to utilize gravel at either Stago or Seven Mile Tank locations for the purpose of repairing the River Road crossing below the Baptist Church.

The foregoing resolution was on August 10, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of five for and two against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
