## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe entered into a Compact with the State of Arizona for the conduct of gaming on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, it has always been the intent and goal of the Tribal Council that the operation of gaming activities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation will reflect the highest standards of honesty and integrity and protect both the clientele as well as the gaming enterprise; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal-State Compact and the Gaming Ordinance of the White Mountain Apache Tribe require that the Tribe establish a Tribal Gaming Office which is empowered to perform the duties assigned by the Tribal Gaming Ordinance and the Tribal Council and to enforce the requirements of the Tribal-State Compact; and
- **WHEREAS**, by previous Resolution No. <u>09-93-244</u>, the Tribal Council appointed the following Commissioners on September 09, 1993 for the teams specified below:
