RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Chediski Timber Sale is included in the ten year cutting budget in the 1991-2000 Forest Management Plan; and
- WHEREAS, the sale contract has been prepared without a formal appraisal; and
- WHEREAS, a formal appraisal will be prepared annually during the Fort Apache Timber Company reappraisal; and
- WHEREAS, the Chediski Timber Sale is in the West Timber Management Area and is part of the annual allowable cut; therefore
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chediski Timber Sale as presented in the proposed contract for the sale of timber, and subject to minor changes and administrative adjustments by the Approving Officer, be sold to the Fort Apache Timber Company as described below:

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council or his representative is authorized to execute the contract and related documents necessary to administer the sale of timber for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that deductions not to exceed thirteen percent (13%) of the gross receipts received from the Purchaser, will be accrued in the Road Suspense Account. This accrual willcontinue until the Road Suspense Account is funded to the extent required to provide the road construction fund reserve authorized by the Tribe.
