

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Tribal Member Matthew Kane has come before the Tribal Council and explained that he needs a new septic tank as he is having sewer problems at his Hondah Homesite; and

WHEREAS, Matthew Kane further advises that the Indian Health Service and Environmental Department of IHS will assist him with a new septic tank, but that it will be necessary to remove some trees from the property to make room for the new septic tank installation; and

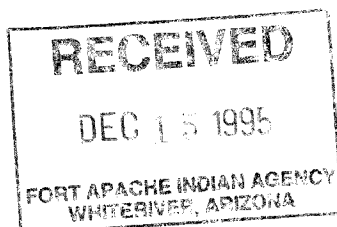
WHEREAS, Mr. Kane has come before the Tribal Council to seek permission to remove approximately seven trees; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Mr. Matthew Kane's request for the removal of the trees on the condition that Tribal Forestry supervise the cutting of said trees to ensure that proper tree cutting methods are utilized and that the aesthetics of the property are preserved and, further, that only necessary trees be removed.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the removal of trees on Matthew Kane's Hondah Homesite property for the sole purpose of permitting the installation of a new septic tank for his home.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that authority to remove trees is conditioned upon Tribal Forester Dennis Bierer, or his designee, inspecting the property and determining which trees shall be cut and how they shall be cut so as to preserve the aesthetics of the property and surrounding properties and to ensure the health and safety of all concerned.

The foregoing resolution was on November 8, 1995 duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (m), (n), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
