

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Mr. Jerry Gloschay, Jr., Manager of the White Mountain Apache Fair and Rodeo Commission, has come before the Tribal Council this date with a request that the Council rescind Resolution No. 10-95-323, which directed that \$5,000 be taken from the Fair and Rodeo Commission fund to pay for "Apaches Unite" activities; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Gloschay also recommends to the Tribal Council that Resolution 10-95-307, which granted \$2,500 travel expenses for tribal members to compete in National Indian Rodeo finals, be charged to the Tribal Fair and Rodeo Commission account; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Gloschay also requests that the Council reserve use of the Memorial Hall for the New Years Eve Ball December 31, 1995, to the Tribal Fair and Rodeo Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after discussion, concludes that there exists good reasons to grant Mr. Gloschay's requests.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby amends Resolution No. 10-95-323 to the effect that the \$5,000, previously expended for "Apaches Unite" activities, be restored to the Fair and Rodeo Commission Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby amends Resolution No. 10-95-307 to the effect that travel expenses for tribal members to compete in the National Indian Rodeo finals in the amount of \$2,500 shall be charged to the Tribal Fair and Rodeo Commission fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby reserves to the Tribal Fair and Rodeo Commission use of the Memorial Hall for a New Years Eve Ball on December 31, 1995.

The foregoing resolution was on December 6, 1995 duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
