BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and appoints Jacob Henry, Gwendena Real Bird, Jonathan Baylish, Bill Walker and Tabatha Johnson to serve with Committee Chair, Margaret Baha-Walker on the Tribal Extension Advisory Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 20, 1995</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (r), (s), (t), and (u) the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
