

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Tribal Member Ms. Loretta Burdette has come to the Tribal Council with a request for assistance to obtain title to her FHA house; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Burdette explains to the Tribal Council that the mortgage was charged off by the Farmers Home Administration and then Rural Housing Trust and that the Internal Revenue Service has charged her a tax on the charged off amount but that she does not have a document stating that she has title to the property; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Legal Department has offered to assist Ms. Burdette in this matter; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council concludes that the Legal Department should be directed to assist her in clarifying the chain of title to her property.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Legal Department to assist Ms. Loretta Burdette to clarify the issue of title to her FHA home.

The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
