

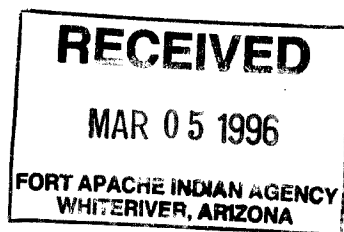
**RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, Land Board Chairman, Slim Quay has come before the Tribal Council requesting approval of land board meeting minutes of November 17, 1995; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the land board meeting minutes and is in agreement that the minutes should be approved without change.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the land board meeting minutes of November 17, 1995 as presented.

The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (h), (l), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Land Board Meeting
November 17, 1995

A monthly Land Board Meeting was held on November 17, 1995 in the Tribal Council Chambers. Members present were: Slim Quay, Lula Ann Ivins and Esther T. Lupe. Rimson Ethelbah was absent. Meeting opened at 9:00 a.m.

1. Hondah Homesite - Lot No. 27, Catherine Armstrong Tointigh to build her own home.
2. Willis Moody relinquished his lot to Ida Mae Garland, so she could have a house built on that land, she will be getting a house built by housing, so this will be her 2nd Choice. Relinquishment and Homesite were approved.
3. Daniel Bahlen, requested a Homesite in the Turkey Creek area, his application was approved.
4. Inez George requested for the remaining land on HUD House, her was told to file an application for the addition.
5. Lucky Holden J. Seven Mile Canyon Road.
6. Erma Sharan Brok Burnette, Whiskey Flat Subdivision.
7. Joplin, Karen, J. Hext, Horse Pasture and Homesite were denied.
8. Paulita Bead, Hondah Homesite No. 62

The Board told Delbert to go to the Livestock Office after he has found another farming area, and ask the Association if the land is under the Association.
