RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Nellie Cody, the daughter of the late Ruth Dahkoshay is still awaiting completion of the HIP house which the Tribal Council, by prior resolution, transferred from Ruth Dahkoshay to Nellie Cody, after her mother's death; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the home is approximately one-half completed and final completion seems to be delayed for unknown reasons; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to direct that the HIP house be completed ASAP so that Nellie Cody and her family can move into said home; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to have the completion delays explained to the Tribal Chairman and Tribal Council.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby orders and directs that the HIP home for Nellie Cody be completed immediately and that delays in completion of the home be explained in writing by the Director of HIP Housing Program to the offices of the Tribal Chairman and Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>March 13, 1996</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
