FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

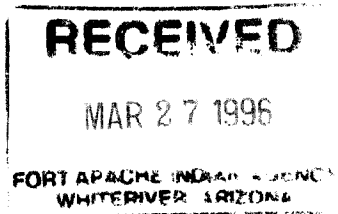
WHEREAS, tribal member, Maybelline Mason, has requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor a Sixteen Song Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance on Saturday, April 27, 1996; and

WHEREAS, Andrew and Olivia Lacapa have been chosen as Godparents, and they have accepted the role; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the Fort Apache Crossing; and


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Maybelline Mason, Sponsor; and Andrew and Olivia Lacapa, Godparents, to hold a Sixteen Song Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance on April 27, 1996 at Fort Apache Crossing..

The foregoing resolution was on March 13, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (g) and (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
