RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Cedar Creek Livestock Association has come before the Tribal Council and asked for assistance to repair livestock fencing removed by the Game and Fish Department for campground development at Horseshoe Lake; and
- WHEREAS, the Cedar Creek Livestock Association needs to have fencing in place by May 1st for the summer grazing.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Game and Fish Department to work with the Cedar Creek Livestock Association to re-construct the fence the Game and Fish Department took down for their campground development work.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Game and Fish Department provide updates to the Cedar Creek Livestock Association on the progress of the work.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 10,1996</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (h), (i), (s), (t), (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
