

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

**WHEREAS**, Stanley and Maybelline Mason have come before the Tribal Council to request a land assignment for a HIP Home; and

**WHEREAS**, the previous location for their home was found to be unsuitable due to the soil structure of the proposed premises; and


**WHEREAS**, the Masons have been waiting to have a home constructed.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the selection of a land site in the vicinity of the Masons earlier land assignment.

The foregoing resolution was on April 10, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t), (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
