- WHEREAS, Mr. Endfield recommends that Harley Janeway be appointed to replace Nashley Tessay, Sr. on the Law and Order Committee; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Mr. Endfield's recommendations.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Harley Janeway to replace Nashley Tessay, Sr. on the Law and Order Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on May 08, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the Article IV, Section 1 (s) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
