RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Council Member Herbert Tate has requested a two acre land assignment on behalf of the Canyon Day Miracle Church; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that no conflicts were found by the Land Board in respect to this request; and
- WHEREAS, the approximate location of the church land assignment is set forth in the attached map, which is incorporated by reference herein; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Land Board has approved this request, but that the formal written approval has not yet been submitted to the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that there is a time urgency for approval of the land assignment prior to a formal submission by the Land Board to the Tribal Council at its next regularly scheduled meeting.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a two acre land assignment for the Canyon Day Miracle Church at the location depicted and represented on the attached map, which is incorporated by reference herein.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that this approval is based upon reliance that the Tribal Land Board has found no conflicts with the land request and that it has approved the requested land assignment.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>May 8, 1996</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section I (a), (h), (i), (m), (n), (q), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
