

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, Jonathan Baylish, President of the Rainbow City Community, has come before the Tribal Council this date with a request that he be designated by the Council as a tribal official authorized to seek funds from Navajo County for the Rainbow City Community, said funds to be requested for the rebuilding of a playground, park, renovation of baseball and softball fields, and repair of community buildings; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Mr. Baylish's request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby designates Mr. Jonathan Baylish, President of the Rainbow City Community, as a tribal official authorized to seek funds from Navajo County for the purpose of obtaining financial assistance to rebuild the baseball and softball fields, the community building, parks, and playgrounds in that community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that any contract or grant conditions offered by Navajo County must first be reviewed by the Tribal Legal Department in the event that Mr. Baylish is successful in obtaining county funds for the purposes outlined in this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 1996 duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (j), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
