

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, tribal member Bernadette Adley-Santa Maria has come before the Tribal Council this date with a request that she be granted permission by the Tribal Council to conduct a questionnaire survey of adult tribal members as part of her Masters Degree Program; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Santa Maria attends the University of Arizona and is enrolled in the Masters program; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Santa Maria has distributed a copy of the questionnaire for adults to the Tribal Council for its review and approval; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Santa Maria explains that she intends to pursue a Ph.D. in the future and advises the Council that she may seek approval for additional and more comprehensive studies involving Apache culture and juvenile delinquency; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after review of the proposed questionnaire, concludes that it should grant approval to Ms. Santa Maria to conduct her questionnaire study.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants tribal member Bernadette Adley-Santa Maria permission to distribute the adult questionnaire in the form and content attached to this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that requests that it hereby Ms. Santa Maria provide a copy of the results of her study to members of the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1996 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section I (a), (i), (g), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
