RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there is a dangerous traffic situation existing at the turn out or entrance across from Paul Ethelbah's house below Cradle Board, commonly known as the old entrance to Jurassic Park; and

WHEREAS, cars exiting that entrance present a danger to oncoming traffic; and

WHEREAS, for highway safety reasons, the Tribal Council concludes that BIA Roads Department should be requested to permanently close the turn-out by fencing or other closure methods.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and requests BIA Roads to close off the turn out across from Paul Ethelbah's home below Cradle Board, commonly known as the old entrance to Jurassic Park, for highway safety reasons.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 16, 1996</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section I (a), (e), (i), (m), (n), (q), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
