RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, a hazardous traffic safety situation exists at the juncture of the FATCO turn-off road and Route 73 because the five lane road becomes a two lane road at the turn-off to FATCO Road; and
- WHEREAS, numerous accidents have taken place because traffic must adjust from two lanes in one direction to one lane in either direction, below the FATCO turn-off going toward Canyon Day, and turning left at FATCO Road; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that a request should be made to the Arizona Department of Transportation for traffic signal lights to be installed at the FATCO Road turn-off at Route 73 to prevent further and more serious accidents.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the Arizona Department of Transportation to install traffic signal lights at the junction of FATCO Road and Route 73 for highway safety reasons.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 16, 1996</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section I (a), (e), (i), (m), (n), (q), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (42 Stat. 984).
