RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Johnny Endfield, Chairman of the Law and Order Committee, advises the Tribal Council that the Law and order Committee has requested that the Tribal Council authorize a budget audit for the Whiteriver Police Department; and
- WHEREAS, the Law and Order Committee is concerned that the Police Department is reportedly \$600,000 over the budget for the current fiscal year; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that an audit should be conducted to determine the financial status of the Police Department and to determine line item expenditures.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Treasurer to arrange for financial audit of the Whiteriver Police Department.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it further directs the Tribal Treasurer to report back to the Tribal Council with audit results.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 16, 1996</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), and (k) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
