

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, tribal members Roger and Alivia Leslie received approval from the Tribal Council for a 25-year homesite lease with a 25-year renewal, by Resolution No. 05-96-118, on May 21, 1996; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Leslie advises the Tribal Council that he has obtained approval from the Land Board for the east lot as directed by Resolution No. 05-96-118; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 05-96-118 did not authorize Mr. and Mrs. Leslie to encumber the leased premises for the purpose of securing financing.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and grants permission to Mr. and Mrs. Leslie to encumber the leased premises described in Resolution No. 05-96-118 for the purpose of securing a loan through the Revolving Credit Program or the HUD 184 Program only, such financing to be arranged solely at Mr. and Mrs. Leslie's sole expense.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the land assignment relinquishment for the leased premises and directs Mr. and Mrs. Leslie to file a land assignment relinquishment with the Land Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 14, 1996, 1996 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
