**WHEREAS**, Janice Chilton is a candidate for State Representative for District IV; and

**WHEREAS**, Janice Chilton supports tribal governments as sovereign nations and has recognized the positive impact of tribal gaming enterprises and resultant economic ventures that have assisted the Tribes to become self-supporting as well as benefitting neighboring towns; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council wishes to endorse her candidacy for State Representative for District IV.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the candidacy of Janice Chilton to be elected as District IV Representative to the State Legislature of Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on October 03, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
