the Tribal Council concludes that approval of the fiscal year 1997 budget in the amount of \$1,246,720 should be granted by the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the proposed Forest Management Deductions Budget and Use Plan for fiscal year 1997 in the form and content attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Forest Management Deductions collected shall be properly deposited and expended on items designated in the Budget and Use Plan and in accordance with 25 CFR and 53 BIAM.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 16, 1996</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (c), (f), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
