

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the General Forestry Regulations; Final Rule, Codified at 25 CFR Part 163 provides the rules, regulations and operating policy that complies with the national Indian Forest Resources Management Act; and

**WHEREAS,** Section 163.25 (f) of the General Forestry Regulations states that "any Forest Management Deductions that have not been incorporated into an approved expenditure plan by the end of the fiscal year following the fiscal year in which deductions are withheld, shall be collected into the general funds of the United States Treasury Pursuant to 25 U.S. C. 413."; and

**WHEREAS,** it is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to maintain the availability of funds for future use to aid in the management of the Tribes Forest Resources; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council concludes that approval of expenditure plans for FY 1998 in the amount of \$1,372,162; FY 1999 in the amount of \$1,509,678; and FY 2000 in the amount of \$630,553 should be granted by the Tribe.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the proposed Expenditure Plan for Fiscal Year 1998, 1999, 2000 in the form and content attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

The foregoing resolution was on December 16, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (c), (f), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


