

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** the White Mountain Apache Tribe entered into a settlement with the federal government for mismanagement of tribal lands in the Court of Claims Case Docket No. 22-D; and
- WHEREAS,** pursuant to the terms of the settlement, each enrolled member of the Tribe received a monetary share of the settlement; and
- WHEREAS,** tribal member, Norberta Alchesay, was erroneously left off the enrollment list and received no payment.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a per capita payment to tribal member, Norberta Alchesay, from the 22-D funds.

The foregoing resolution was on January 8, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (e), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 19933, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
