**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Members identified on the attached Sunrise Dance Schedule have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor Sunrise Dances at the dates and locations identified; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has reviewed the requests; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has directed that all Sunrise sponsors sign and abide by the Waste Disposal Requirements for Camps.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the attached 1997 Sunrise Dance Schedule for the dates, locations, and sponsors identified therein.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that each sponsor read, sign, and abide by the Waste Disposal Requirements for Camps attached to this resolution.


The foregoing resolution was on January 8, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (g), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

**1. Disposal of regular trash**

Camp Organizers, make arrangements with a waste disposal co.\* to leave dumpster(s) at camp locations when your camp is ready. Please ensure container is sufficient for your needs.

**2. Disposal of vegetation and construction debris used as structures, fencing and shade.**

Community Service or Solid Waste Department need to be called so they can dispose of branches and scrap building material for you. Please call early to ensure a vehicle will be available. Truck rate is \$15.00 per half day and \$25.00 for a full day. If there are any questions and/or comments, please call.

# PROPER WASTE DISPOSAL FOR CAMPS

**Sunrise Dance camps and Church gatherings need a waste disposal system for trash and debris generated for the duration of the camp. When these spiritual happenings are over, there is trash scattered throughout the sites and in the streams. With the proper assistance from Tribal Departments, We can help keep these areas beautiful.**

Trash and debris attract insects and animals which might carry diseases and possibly contaminate the water and foodstuff. For this problem, **waste disposal companies will deposit a dumpster at the campsite for a minimum fee.** This will assist in trash elimination .

Vegetation and construction debris used as shade and fencing will be disposed of by Tribal Departments. **The Solid Waste Department and Community Service Program will haul vegetation and structural debris for a small charge.**

These requirements are subject to White Mountain Apache Tribe Solid Waste Ordinance (October 1995) with its attendant guidelines and penalties. This will help encourage People to respect and keep our land clean.
